Casa Vida y Esperanza is a 25 acre Christian children's home whose purpose is to mentor young lives with truth, love, and hope for today and forever. This includes meeting their physical, mental, and spiritual needs through education, training, and by providing them with a secure and stable home life.

The first time Carl visited the children's home and spent time with these children he realized he had to come back. For the past three years he participates as part of a volunteer construction work team focusing on improving the campus. At that time, the property contained a large main house and several buildings, although most were in appalling condition. A tremendous amount of cleaning, repair, remodeling and new additions, all done by the small staff and volunteer work teams, allowed CVE to receive their first children in February 2005.

Today the orphanage houses more than 40 children ranging in age from infancy to 21. CVE is in the process of building additional housing for children, as the need continues to grow.
